Life Journey: Chapters 1 and 2

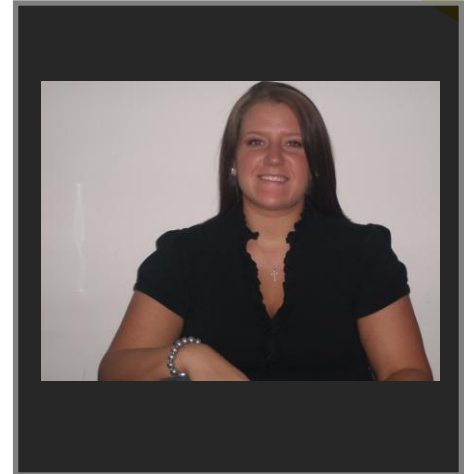
