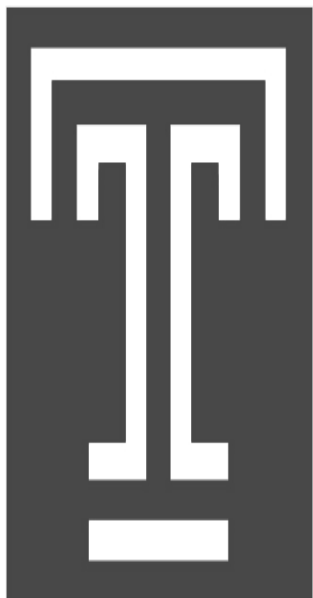

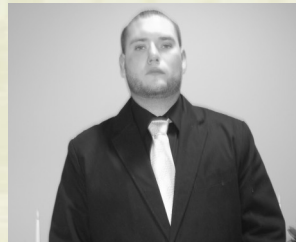


BACKGROUND INFORMATION
